



Finding an In-Network Provider is Easy

Switching to Highmark Blue Shield doesn't have to mean changing doctors.

Check if your providers are in-network with the Find a Provider tool.

- 1 Visit [MyHighmark.com](https://myhighmark.com) or Scan the QR code.



- 2 Choose location and plan.
- 3 Enter your address, city, or zip code to continue.
- 4 Choose 'Don't know your Alpha Prefix?' Browse a list of plans.
- 5 Select your plan from the drop down box.

You may see "Pennsylvania" listed under "Available plans." This is for informational purposes and can be ignored. Please continue by selecting your specific plan, as noted below, from the options provided.

National PPO Network

You will have access to more than **1.7 million doctors and hospitals** across the country, the largest network of doctors and hospitals offered by Blue Cross and Blue Shield System. You have out of network coverage with the National PPO Coverage.

Please note, you could pay more if your visit an out-of network doctor, specialist or hospital. You may choose to any specialist without a referral and any hospital/facility for admission (both in- and out-of-network).
