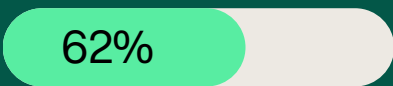
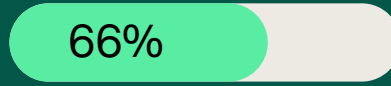

Support and education to both parents and expecting parents on the family system and challenges that may come with child development

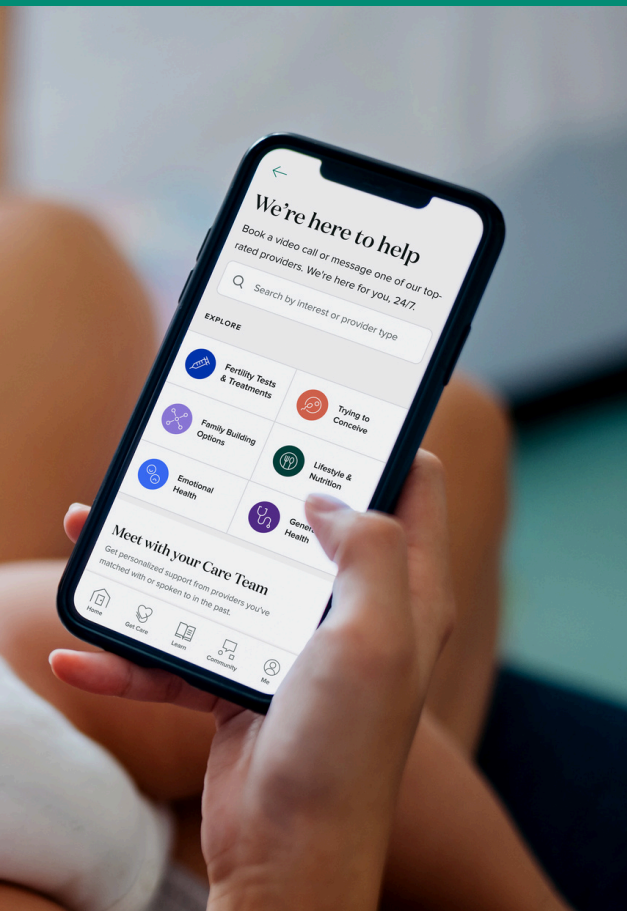


Developmental Psychologists
