

## Whitelisting guide for encrypted emails to distribute total rewards statements

| Problem  |  |
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| "Emails from flimp.net aren't being received or they go to my spam/junk folder." |  |
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To ensure your team receives encrypted-email messages with their total rewards statements, please whitelist the sender address <u>trs-distribution@flimp.net</u>. This prevents emails from being marked as junk or spam and helps guarantee smooth delivery.

## Steps to take:

- Contact your IT team and ask them to add <u>trs-distribution@flimp.net</u> to your organization's "Safe Senders and Domains" list or mark it as important within your internal system.
- 2. **Choose a small test group**—ideally one person or up to five benefits-team contacts—to receive a test email. This allows both our team and yours to confirm the messages are being delivered correctly and not flagged as spam.
- 3. **Review the test emails** and let us know if there are any issues with delivery, formatting or other concerns.
