



Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act

The Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998 requires medical plans that offer mastectomy benefits to also provide coverage for reconstructive surgery. Our medical plans provide benefits for mastectomy-related services, including reconstruction and surgery to achieve symmetry between the breasts, prostheses, and complications resulting from a mastectomy (including lymphedema).
