

Virtual visits are covered the same as an exam in the dentist's office,* but you may have out-of-pocket costs. Your annual maximum and frequency limitations will also apply.

How do teledentistry visits work?

You'll meet with the dentist for a video appointment, using your computer, smartphone or tablet. Just explain your symptoms, or show the dentist the problem you're experiencing, and they'll evaluate your issue and advise what to do next.

Book a Teledentix appointment.

If your regular dentist doesn't offer virtual visits, you can schedule one through the Teledentix service. You'll be connected to an available dentist in just minutes.
