What is the overall <u>deductible</u>? If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u>?	Yes. In-Network Preventive Health care, certain services with a <u>copayment</u> , and <u>prescription drugs</u> are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes
