The Diagnosis.

At our recent Town Hall, we had the privilege of hearing from Thomas Gagan, a remarkable young boy whose journey reminds us why our work at ImmunoTek is so important. At just seven years old, Thomas has already shown remarkable resilience. Born prematurely and later diagnosed with Specific Antibody Deficiency (SAD), his body cannot produce the antibodies needed to fight infections or respond to vaccines. For the past four years, Thomas has relied on bi-weekly **IVIG** treatments made possible through plasma donations to stay healthy.

Life Beyond Treatment.

Thomas is a joyful, active child who loves playing with cars and tractors, fishing at the lake, and spending time with his dog, Diesel. His favorite game, Pie Face, always makes him laugh. His mom (Beth) describes him as the "smartest 7-year-old I know" and says his smile brightens every room.

Whether you're celebrating Halloween or just enjoying the fall season, here are a few tips to help keep the festivities flowing and the workplace safe!

- **Costume Guidelines.** Avoid masks, excessive face paint, or props that may obstruct vision, hinder mobility, or pose infection risks. No loose clothing that could get caught in equipment.
- Safe Decorations. Keep hallways, exits, and emergency equipment (fire extinguishers, eyewash stations, etc) clear of decorations. Candles and open flames are not permitted. Use battery or electric lights instead.
- **Trip Hazards and Emergency Exits.** Secure cords for decorative lights and ensure floor decorations don't create slips, trips, or falls. Decorations should not block signage, fire alarms, or emergency exits.
- **PPE First.** Costumes should never interfere with proper glove use, lab coats, or PPE compliance.
- **Food Safety.** If treats are shared, avoid homemade items. Provide only sealed, individually wrapped snacks to protect against cross-contamination. Clearly label treats that contain nuts or other common allergens.
- **Sanitization.** Wipe down decorated areas and high-touch surfaces regularly. Do not pass around costume props or communal makeup. Maintain standard protocols, such as glove changes and hand washing.
- Friendly, Not Frightening. Be respectful. Not everyone chooses to celebrate Halloween. Gory or scary costumes and decorations may be alarming to our donors or team members. Keep it lighthearted and welcoming!



With these tips, we can keep this month safe, festive, and friendly.
