

What Is the Baseline Visit?

The **Baseline Visit** is a key component of the Curative Health Plan designed to help members establish a foundation for personalized, coordinated care. It's a one-time health assessment that must be completed within the **first 120 days** of coverage to unlock full plan benefits.

Why It Matters

Completing your Baseline Visit ensures:

- **\$0 cost access** to in-network care for the remainder of the plan year
- Continued use of the **Curative Cash Card** beyond the initial 120-day window
- A personalized care plan tailored to your health needs
- Improved coordination between Curative and your providers

What to Expect During the Visit

The Baseline Visit typically includes:

- A review of your medical history
- Basic lab work and screenings
- Preventive care assessments
- A discussion of your health goals and needs

It's not a full physical exam, but rather a structured health check-in to help Curative support your care journey.

How to Schedule

Deadline

You must complete the Baseline Visit **within 120 days of your coverage start date** to maintain full access to Curative's \$0 benefits and extended use of the Curative Cash Card.
