DID YOU KNOW?

In 2024, there were 181,464 prescriptions filled by FBISD employees and dependents. Only 3.7% were filled through mail order.





The Fort Bend ISD prescription benefit plan offers **Maintenance Choice**®, a program which gives employees the option to pick up or get delivery of 90-day supplies of the medication they take regularly (for things like diabetes, high blood pressure, asthma, etc.) at select participating pharmacies.

Maintenance Choice helps keep employees' medication as affordable as possible.

- Kelsey UHC Charter Plan covers a 90-supply prescription at a coinsurance amount not to exceed \$150.
- Surest Plan covers a 90-day supply prescription at a coinsurance amount not to exceed \$150.
- Choice HSA Plan covers a 90-day supply prescription at a deductible and coinsurance amount not to exceed \$150.

Employees can save money when they fill a 90-day supply prescription through mail order or at one of the maintenance choice network pharmacies (CVS, Kroger, Costco).
