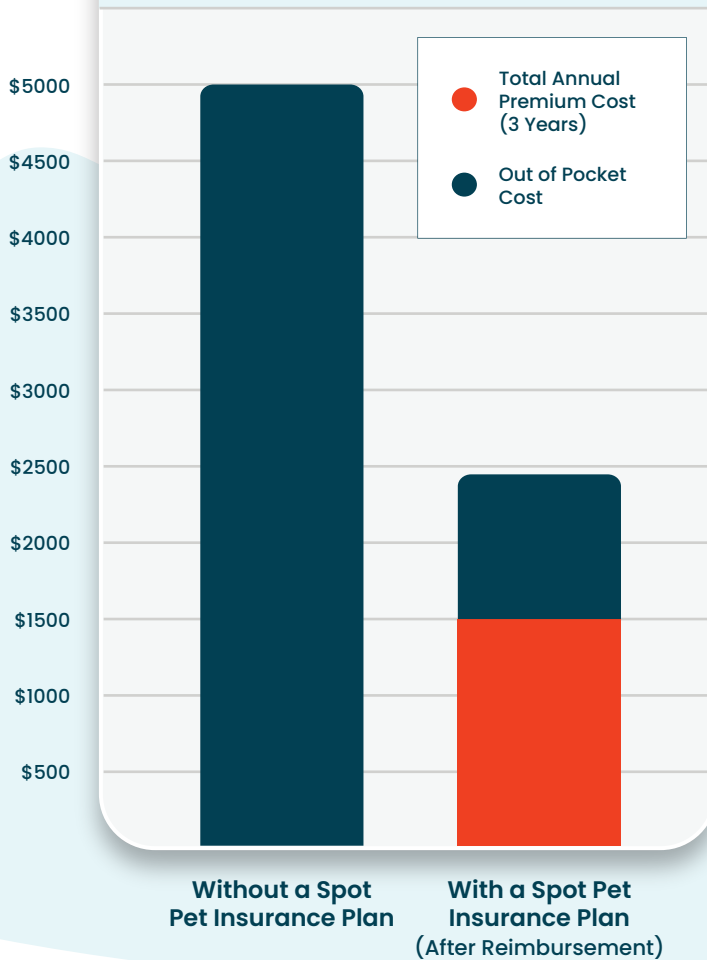


Don't Wait for the Emergency to Happen
